ASH WEDNESDAY (The Beginning of Lent): Will be on Wednesday **14th February.** Ash Wednesday is the first day of the liturgical season of Lent. It is a day when Catholics go to Mass and in addition to receiving the word of God and the Eucharist, we receive Blessed Ashes on our foreheads in the shape of a cross. We receive them as a sign of the beginning of the season of Lent, the season of penance and preparation for Easter. Ash Wednesday along with Good Friday are days Catholics are required to do Fasting and Abstinence. Masses are as follows: St Bernard's Church **9am**; Our Lady of the Rosary Church **7pm.**

21st Feb. Ash Wed. Masses: Our Lady of the Rosary School **9:25am**; St Bernard's School **2.00pm.**

STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT: We are invited to join the Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent at **7pm** at **St Bernard's Parish.** The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day.

LENTEN RECONCILIATION: Bishop Declan invites us all to join him during this season of Lent to celebrate the abundant mercy of God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Join him at one of the five venues across our diocese as part of your Lenten Journey. The nearest to our parish is being held on **Wednesday 6th March 7pm** at the **Holy Family Church, Patchway.**

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION (Outpouring of the Holy Spirit) 2024: The Classes will commence on **Sunday 25th February 2024** at **4pm** at Our Lady of the Rosary Church. The Confirmation ceremony takes place at **7pm** on **Thursday 4th July 2024.**

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PREPARATION: Many more Families have signed their children up for this year's preparation and it is good that our Children are journeying towards the Sacraments. The programmes begin as follows: St Bernard's at **5pm** on **Tuesday 27th February**; Our Lady of the Rosary at **10am** on **Saturday 24th February.**
